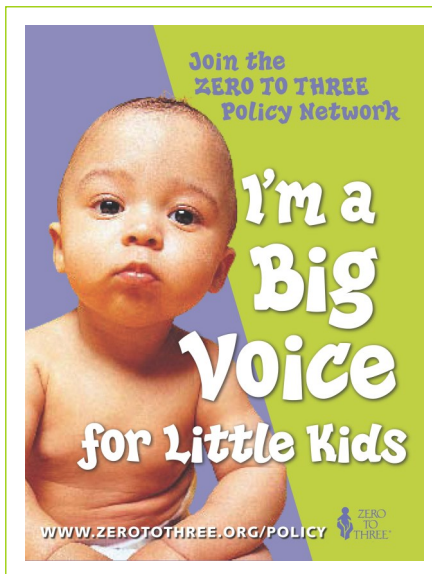


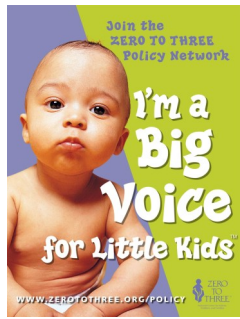

## ADVOCACY DEVELOPMENTAL MILESTONE

### Take Action Now!

The results from the **Mobile-ize for Babies: The First 100 Days Poll** are in! This month's advocacy challenge is to share the poll results with your policymakers. Read below to find out how!

### It's as Easy as 1-2-3

1. Download the [poll results flyer](#).
2. Look up the names and contact information for your elected officials [here](#).
3. Send the poll results page to each one by either:
  - **Email** - Type an email introducing yourself as a constituent and explaining that you think it's important that they make infants, toddlers, and families a priority while setting their agenda during the first 100 days. Include a link to the poll results with your message.
  - **Snail Mail** - Print out a color copy of the results page and mail it along with an introductory letter (using the same message suggested above).
  - **Tweet** - Many elected officials have Twitter accounts, including the [President](#) and several members of the [U.S. House of Representatives](#) and the [U.S. Senate](#). You can send a tweet to your elected officials and direct them to check out the poll results. Here's a suggested tweet:

@WhiteHouse: Make babies a top priority during the 1st 100 days. <http://bit.ly/WEEReE> #mobilize4babies

4. Don't forget to send the results to your friends, family, and colleagues (particularly those who took the poll) and ask them to pass it along to their elected officials as well!
